To get the mouse working, first you need the MAC address of your mouse...

You get it with following command in a shell (assumes, you have bluez-util installed)

1.
hcitool scan

To pair your mouse, you can execute the following command in a shell

1.
sudo hidd --connect XX:XX:XX:XX:XX:XX

To have it always automatically paired, you can set the two variables like the following sample in the file `/etc/default/bluetooth`

1.
HIDD_ENABLED=1

2.
HIDD_OPTIONS="-i XX:XX:XX:XX:XX:XX --server"
