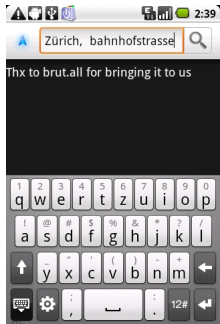

NavStarter - Starting Google Navigation the easy way

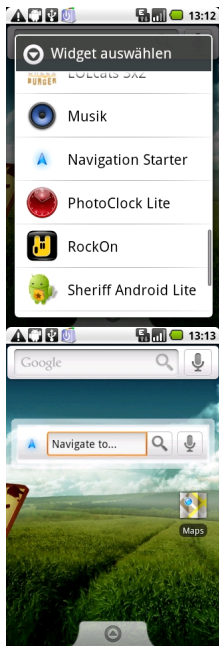
